Introduction

- In ITEA we have to support our consortia to cooperate globally
 - Industry partners need to extend their cooperation into growing economies
 - Developing global standards requires early involvement of technology leaders at the global level

- ITEA has its roots in Europe but is a front-runner in EUREKA for successful global cooperations:
 - Turkey, a full EUREKA member, had its first participation in ITEA in Call 6 in 2004 and has become the number 2 proposer in ITEA 3 Call 1 POs in 2014.
 - Korea had its first participation in ITEA in Call 7 in 2005 and has become an important participant in ITEA 2 and ITEA 3; the Republic of Korea has been an associated member of EUREKA since 2009
 - Others have participated a few times, e.g. Egypt, Ukrain, Canada, Singapore
