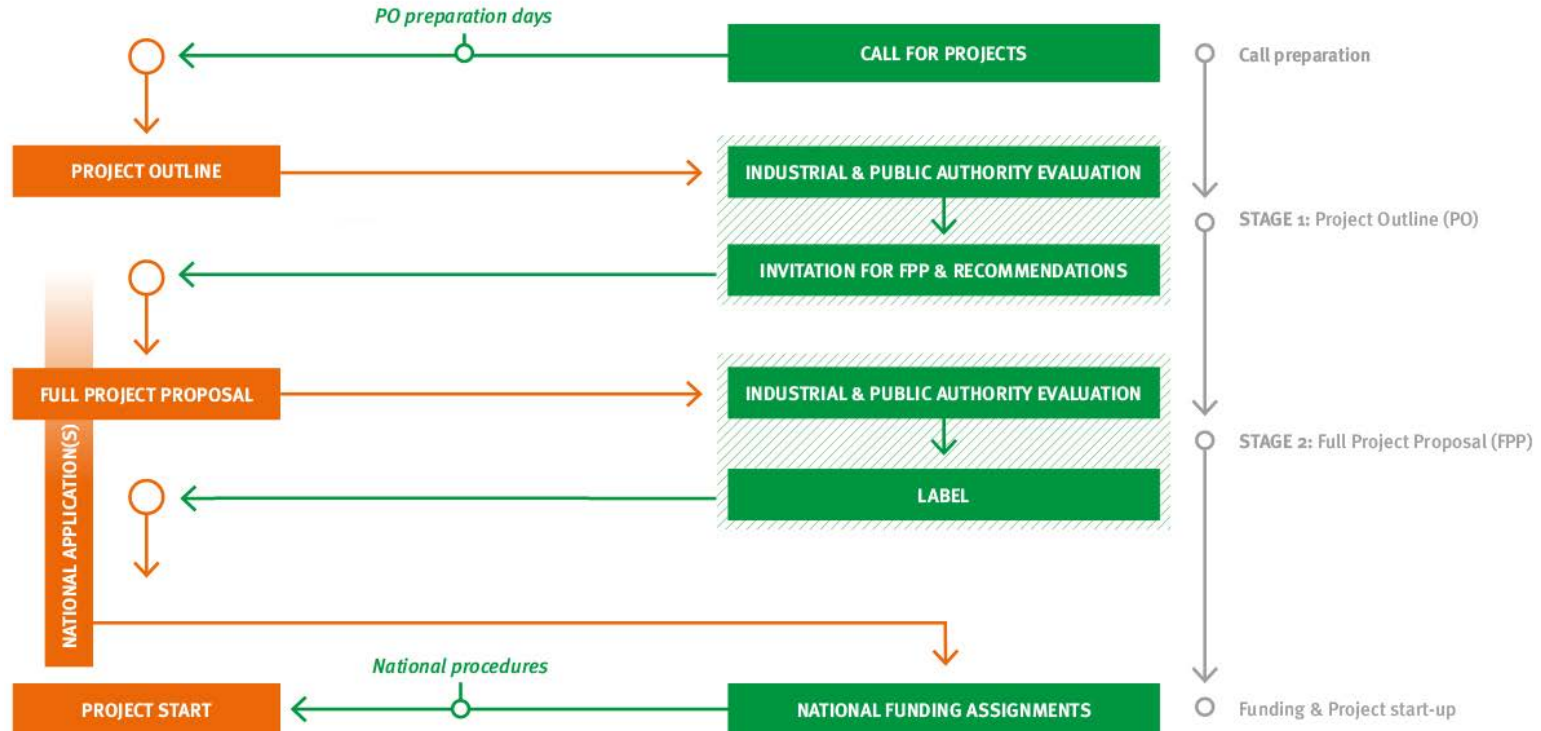

# Call process in detail

## ITEA & PUBLIC AUTHORITIES



- 4 September 2018      Opening of ITEA 3 Call 5
- 4-5 September 2018      Project Outline (PO) preparation meeting, Stockholm, project idea generation and partner finding
- **30 October 2018**      **Deadline submission of PO**
- 03 December 2018      Accepted POs invited for submission of Full Project Proposals (FPPs)
- **14 February 2019**      **Deadline for submission of FPPs**
-  22 March 2019      Announcement of labelling results

- ITEA projects are industry driven, technically innovative and focused on business results.
- The EUREKA rules that are applicable to the ITEA projects and partners include the following:
  - Project consortia need to have at least two different organisations from two different countries (one must be a EUREKA Member Country and another one either a EUREKA Member Country or a EUREKA Associated Country ).
  - The Project Leader must be from an organisation established in a EUREKA Member Country or a EUREKA Associated Country
  - Partners from non-EUREKA countries may participate in a project provided all participants agree

- The ITEA label implies that the ITEA organisation recommends the project to the Public Authorities (PAs) for public funding.
- From ITEA 3 Call 3 onwards, the ITEA label awarded to an ITEA project automatically expires after 10 months when the project has not started within this period, unless the ITEA BSG and ITAC jointly decide otherwise.
- An ITEA label, however, does not automatically imply funding for the project; each partner must apply for funding in its own country.
- The rules for national application submission, eligibility criteria and funding possibilities differ per country and may change over time.

  - Several PAs will have a pitch today 
  - A project leader should monitor the funding status of each partner country
- Public funding is not a pre-requisite for a partner to participate in a project.
